Bob and Nick,

In accordance with the Collective Bargaining Agreement, Article 9, Section 12G, a vote was conducted among the members of the Motor Transportation Bargaining Unit on 13 March, 2005.

As a result of that vote it is requested that the following accepted motions be recognized when administering the Motor Transportation Bargaining Unit's Overtime Rules and Out of Area Agreement.

Motion #1. "Effective immediately and at the end of each calendar year, accumulated overtime hours of the employees in an overtime work group will be zeroed and the list for each individual overtime work group will be reestablished in seniority order."

Motion #2 "Effective immediately and at the end of each calendar year, accumulated hours of the members on the Out of Area List will be zeroed and the Out of Area List will remain in the order that it is in."

Barring any objections from the company it is respectfully requested that the above motions be made effective with the pay period that begins 4 April 2005.
