Receives, sorts, verifies, counts, indentifies, stores, packs, wraps issues and maintains inventory of all incoming stock, non-stock material, tools and equipment returned from various field locations and power plants. In Performance of duties, interacts repetitively with the computerized warehouse records, inputs and/or corrects source documents into D.T.E. tracking systems using various computer software applications. Responsible for day to day security and maintenance at various Investment Recovery work locations.

Other Duties/Duties As Assigned:

Drives and operates vehicles, forklifts, pallet mover, pendant crane, line trucks, pental hook trailers less than 24 feet, 30 ton fork lift, front end loader, basic rigging, snow removal equipment, etc. Performs required inspection of safety harnesses and testing of various meter equipment. Measures and cuts wire/cable. Loads and unloads cable reels, streetlight posts, wire, transformers and associated material. Operates wire spooling and wire cutting machines. May operate plasma torch and repair transformers when needed.
